



## **St. Liborius Knights of Columbus – Council 14562 Catholic High School Scholarship Instructions**

### **Scholarship Program Introduction**

The St. Liborius Knights of Columbus is proud to offer a scholarship for financial assistance for high school grades 9-12. This scholarship will be awarded to active St. Liborius parishioner students whose family is in need of financial assistance and is entering any year in any Catholic high school.

### **General Scholarship Application Information**

All active parishioners of St. Liborius who are seeking admittance to a catholic high school are eligible. Four scholarships of \$500.00 each, are being offered. Each scholarship is for one student selected from each of the four high school grades (Freshman, Sophomore, Junior and Senior), and will be sent to any Catholic high school of the student's choosing on behalf of that student. Families must reapply for a new scholarship each year.

Applications are available on the backside of this instruction bulletin, on the St. Liborius website and at the St. Liborius parish office. Applications are reviewed as received and are on a first-come, first served basis. The scholarship will be awarded in August of the new school year.

The \$500.00 scholarship will be paid directly to the selected applicants' Catholic high school of choice, by the Knights of Columbus Council 14562 Scholarship Review Board.

### **Specific Scholarship Application Information**

- The applicant must be a legal guardian of the student.
- The applicant must be a registered member of St. Liborius parish for at least 6 months prior to the start of the school year. Note: Applicants who have recently moved into our parish from another, must have a letter from the priest or deacon of the previous parish, stating that they were an active member of that parish (please attach that letter to the application).
- All completed applications must be returned by mail or hand-delivered to the parish office before July 1<sup>st</sup> of the new school year.
- Along with the completed application, the student must submit a one-page letter stating why he/she wants to attend a Catholic high school and the need for a scholarship. The letter can be typed or hand-written, but must be legible if hand-written.
- The student and applicant must share the gift of time (attend Mass regularly), talent (be involved in at least one ministry of the parish), and treasure (envelope, if able) every week, through sacrificial giving to St. Liborius. Father will make the decision on parish commitment of time, talent and treasure for the student and applicant.
- The decision to award the scholarship to the Catholic high school mentioned in the application, on behalf of the student applicant, as made by the Knights of Columbus Council 14562 Scholarship Board, in conjunction with St. Liborius Church, is final.
